

## APPLECROSS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL School Dress Code

The Applecross Senior High School uniform enhances the public image of our school and has a positive impact on student self esteem. It also enhances a student's sense of belonging and pride in the school community. In addition, from a safety and security aspect, school uniform assists in identifying whether an individual is entitled to be on school grounds.

Being suitably groomed is part of the process by which students learn the importance of self image and to engage with employers and the community. As a student of our School, it is expected that students are clean, well groomed, appropriately and neatly dressed at all times. Denim or any jean fabric is not part of the School Uniform under any circumstances.

The School Council has endorsed the school policy that:

- every student will wear the School Uniform,
- uniform items are purchased from the School Uniform Shop, and
- students arriving at school will be clean and neatly dressed.

The School Uniform was updated in December 2008 after extensive research and consultation by a P&C sub committee comprising of students, parents and teachers for the commencement of the 2009 school year. The proposal includes that all uniform items are stocked by the School Uniform Shop and that old items will be phased out over one year.

The School Uniform Shop is managed and operated by Uniform Concepts ensuring that stocks of all items are available in the correct style with a range of suitable sizing for all students. Special fittings are available for non-standard sizes and garments made to measure for a minimal charge.

### ITEM RANGE FOR BOTH UPPER AND LOWER SCHOOL

School jacket—black, red and green, zip front, with school logo  
Grey woollen jumper with school name in black lettering  
Black scarf with school logo

Plain black box pleated skirt  
Plain black hip fit align skirt  
Plain black boys five pocket pants

### LOWER SCHOOL UNIFORM

Red polo shirt with school logo  
Black bottom garments available through the Uniform Shop as listed above for whole school wear

### UPPER SCHOOL UNIFORM

White polo shirt with school logo  
White boys shirt with School logo  
White girls fitted blouse with School logo  
Black bottom garments available through the Uniform Shop as listed above for whole school wear

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

White PE polo shirt with school logo  
Green PE shorts with school logo  
Please note: School PE track pants with school logo are available but not stocked

### SPECIAL TENNIS UNIFORM

White and red tennis polo shirts with school logo  
Red shorts with school logo  
Tennis jacket—black, white, red and green, zip front, with school logo

### FOOTWEAR

Health and safety provisions require all students to wear flat, enclosed footwear while attending school at all times, preferably in a neutral colour. When students are officially representing the School it is preferable that standard, black footwear is worn.

### ACCESSORIES

Black scarf resembling black school scarf  
Opaque black tights can be worn with skirts only  
Cultural or religious head garments that have been notified to the School

### INAPPROPRIATE ITEMS

It is not appropriate to wear:

- PE uniform during other classes;
- track pants of any sort as they are not part of the School Uniform;
- black or coloured tights with shorts;
- excessive jewellery, eg hooped earrings, large bracelets, etc;
- excessive makeup;
- rainwear or jackets except to or from school, other than the School Jacket as part of the School Uniform;
- torn or frayed clothing;
- boots of any style, including ugg boots;
- variations of enclosed footwear that do not complement the School Uniform; or
- clothing items not purchased from the School Uniform Shop.

Any student who arrives at school out of School Uniform needs to make a request for a 'clothing pass' from the Clothing Coordinator prior to care group. The pass is to be worn by the student and presented to all staff members who enquire about the student's clothing. Students who know that they will not be attired according to the School Dress Code on a particular day are to take responsibility for providing the Clothing Coordinator with a note from their parent/guardian with an explanation. The note should be presented at the time of requesting the pass and will be processed by the Coordinator.

It should be noted by parents that non-compliance with the School Uniform standard would only be acceptable in an emergency situation. Students who are not wearing the School Uniform will receive an 'After School Detention Notification' if they do not have an explanatory note from a parent/guardian. Consistent presentation of a parent note is not acceptable and will result in after school detention (a maximum of 10 dress passes).

Applecross Senior High School students share the benefits of a reputation of high academic achievements and success in the arts, sports and community service. Please show that you are proud to be a member of this school by reflecting its good image in the way you dress. Families who choose to enrol their children at Applecross Senior High School are expected to support the Dress Code developed by the school community which means purchasing all School Uniform items from the Uniform Shop that conform to style and colours.
