1. You must choose **SIX** courses plus FIVE reserve options. Please refer to the Year 11 Subject Information Handbook 2021, which is available online at [www.applecross.wa.edu.au](http://www.applecross.wa.edu.au).
2. One of these courses **must be English, Literature or English as an Additional Language/Dialect course.**  
Information about unacceptable course combinations are listed below:
  - English **with** English as an Additional Language/Dialect
  - English as an Additional Language/dialect **with** Literature
  - Students cannot select an ATAR and General course that has the same code. eg GEVAR and AEVAR - same last 3 letters.
3. You must ensure that at least one course from List A and one from List B is studied. At least one course from each of List A and B must be studied through to Year 12.
4. If you choose both Maths Methods and Maths Applications, only one of these subjects will count towards your ATAR score. See a Counsellor for further explanation.
5. **IMPORTANT:** In the grid on the next page, students are required to select only one subject per line. Many subjects occur on multiple lines, e.g. Maths, English. The easiest way of choosing your subjects is to select the one occurrence subjects first, e.g. Economics, Visual Arts, etc. Then, fill in the remaining lines with the multiple occurrence classes.
