

Student Code of Conduct

Our Code of Conduct describes the behaviours that students are expected to learn and demonstrate at school. In order to maintain a safe and supportive school environment:

- Students are required to follow all lawful directions and instructions of all school staff.
- Students are expected to use language that is respectful and inclusive of people of all races, religions, genders and sexualities.
- Students are required to adhere to the Applecross SHS Uniform policy.
- Students need to remain in their own designated area of the grounds or a communal activity location during break times.
- Students are expected to behave, write and publish to represent themselves and the school in a positive way. This includes behaviour in public places when in school uniform, and maintaining a positive digital reputation.

- All students have a responsibility to contribute to a safe school, free of threats or actual violence, verbal abuse or bullying of any kind.
- Students should not engage in inappropriate intimate physical contact with other members of the school community.
- Students are required to follow the terms of the Applecross SHS Computer Acceptable use policy.
- Students must adhere to the Applecross SHS Electronic Devices policy.
- Prohibited, illegal, and restricted substances are not permitted on school grounds.
 Examples include alcohol, vaping devices, tobacco, illegal drugs, prescription drugs intended for misuse, any item that could be used as a weapon, aerosol cans, chewing gum and any other substances that may be used for illicit purposes.
